

THE CLAN MACPHERSON ASSOCIATION GATHERING 2019

Friday 2 August – Monday 5 August

The Gathering this year will follow the traditional format, including Pipes Galore. We shall be using the Duke of Gordon Hotel for the Ball, the supper and the Ceilidh, which means there is a very firm limit on numbers attending these events. There will be a slight change to the ceilidh this year in that it will start ½ hour earlier to give the juniors a chance to dance. Surprisingly the Gathering takes quite a bit of time and effort to organize; please be kind to us and get your booking in early.

Pipes Galore Following its success last year, this will happen again. Clan pipers will play some of their favourite tunes, as well as talking about the composers and the stories behind the tunes. So often we hear the tunes without understanding the melodies and the events that shaped them. The Great Highland Bagpipe is the only musical instrument that has ever been proscribed as a weapon of war, with the penalty for playing it being death. Many only know its stirring marches yet, in the right hands, it can be hugely versatile, with styles ranging from laments to reels, from piobaireachd to marches. Come along and find the soul of the instrument.

Dress code Most events at the Gathering do not have a dress code – just wear what you feel comfortable in for the occasion – the exceptions being the Dinner and Ball, and the Saturday March. The **Dinner and Ball is Highland Dress/Formal** and the **March on Saturday afternoon is Smart Day Wear** (kilt for men, with jacket and tie; smart tartan knee-length or slightly longer skirt for women). Please remember that this is a formal march supporting our Chief, and attracts attention from local people and visitors so, please, neither mini nor full length skirts, no trainers/sneakers, sandals or other casual items, and no pets.

Numbers are limited for the events and tickets will be supplied on a first come, first served basis. If fully subscribed, a waiting list will operate. **Please notify the Secretary as soon as possible if booked tickets are not required, to allow speedy re-allocation.**
