The hotel, which is just a short walk from Perth city centre, has a fully-equipped leisure club and heated indoor swimming pool, is situated next to the bus station and opposite the railway station, and also has its own car park.

The bed and breakfast rate for Burns Supper attendees is **£70 for a double room** and **£50 for a single**. This price will apply right up until the day of the event, but rooms will not be held for us so it would be a good idea to book as soon as you can; just say that you are attending the CMA Burns Supper. Bookings may be cancelled up to three days before the event at no penalty.
